Admission to the Government Colleges and 50% Government seats of self-financing colleges is limited to Indian citizens of Kerala origin and those who have studied/are studying in educational institutions of Kerala from class VIII to XII will also be treated on a par with Indian citizens for admission to the course.

On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of Kerala has decided to issue an Essentiality Certificate for the same. It shall be the duty of the applicant to produce evidence that the infrastructural facilities such as teaching preclinical para clinical and allied Dental sciences are owned by the proposed Dental College. The Institution will execute a consensual agreement with the Government to share 50% of seats.

The Essentiality Certificate is valid for the academic year 2016-17 onwards
